Dear Parishioner

We now have a new Clerk, a new website and telephone number. Dinah Cheek retired in March this year and Barbara Appleby is our new Clerk. A new council was elected in May 2007 with several new councillors as listed opposite.



Key Sites – North of Thorne Lane – hedges were removed last year in preparation for the roads coming off the site onto Thorne Land and Larkhill Road. This has to be done when birds are not nesting. Since then there has been no obvious progress.

East of Lyde Road – Recently there has been another public consultation and a further planning application is anticipated. In general there did not appear much difference from the previously present layout. We were not happy with apparent lack of community facilities, in particular health provision and we have written about this to the Primary Care Trust.



Newsletters

Recently some Yeovil Town Council Newsletters were delivered in our parish causing questions about boundary changes. If you are receiving this Newsletter you are still in the Parish of Yeovil Without. Previously we reported on Parish Boundary meetings, and the Town Council wish to absorb our parish. The matter was delayed until after Local Elections and is still not finished.



Allotments – This year we extended the allotment site, and by halving some this has increased to 21 plots. We have improved the water supply and plan to continue to improved conditions. If you are interested please contact the Clerk.

Grants - In the last few years the Council have responded to grant applications. We have made substantial contributions to Birchfield Community Centre, Johnson Park sports facilities, Yeovil Marsh Church Hall, Abbey Community Hall and Five Ways Therapy Pool. We have also supported many local charities including St Margarets Hospice, Air Ambulance and The Citizens Advice Bureau.

Sports Zone - Over a year ago the District Council published the Sports Zone proposal to be developed on the Mudford Road Recreation ground which included a new entry road from Combe Street Lane. Our parish borders this green area and many local people are opposing the development, being very active in the local press. Individually Parish Councillors do not support the proposed Sports Zone, but the time may come when the Council has to formally consider a planning application. Recently Parish councillors have surveyed all the play areas within the parish. Lyde Ward has four, Brimsmore has two, and Combe Ward only one, at Yeovil Marsh which emphasises the value of Mudford Rec.

Representatives -

Councillors continue to represent on local committees including Birchfield and Abbey Community Centre, Yeovil Sports and Social Club (Johnson Park), Woburn's Almshouses, Cemetery and Crematorium Committee, Westfield Association and various charities.



Bus Shelters – The Parish Council have increased the number of bus shelters by 2 in Lyde Road and Cavalier Way.
