## NOTICE

1. Date of announcement 6<sup>th</sup> June 2017
2. Section 26 and 27 of the Local Audit and Accountability Act 2014 provide for:
  - **Inspection: Any person interested** may inspect and make copies of the Annual Return and all books, deeds, contracts, bills, vouchers and receipts etc. relating to them. For the year ended 31<sup>st</sup> March 2017 these documents will be available during the period specified in paragraph 4 on reasonable notice on application to the person in paragraph 3 below.
  - **Questions and objections** to the external auditor: Local Government **electors** and their representatives have rights to:
    - question the auditor about the accounting records: and
    - object to the accounts or any item in them. Written notice of an objection must first be given to the external auditor and a copy sent to the Authority. Objections must concern a matter of which the external auditor could make a public interest report or apply for a declaration that an item of account is unlawful.
